2. 3rd Party Insurance:

Cost around £180pa (not £80 as wrongly reported by DT). Would protect us if sued for frightening some thoroughbred livestock into an early grave. Should we invest in this?

3. Hash run fee:

Boxing Day : No hash, but the Boxing Day Race round Clevedon will have several hashers. Come and join in or support your fellow hashers. The race starts at 11am from Salthouse Field car park on the sea front. Wear your Bogs Hash tee-shirt (if you haven't got one order from DT without delay).
